Styling Tips

Keep accessories minimal and purposeful Ensure clothing is clean, ironed, and lint-free Shoes should be clean and match the style of the outfit Bring a backup outfit just in case

Wear something you've tested before and know you love If in doubt, keep it simple and classic Ask your photographer if you're unsure—they're happy to advise The most important thing: wear a smile and your confidence!
